How to measure your head circumference?

To determine the correct helmet size for you, follow these simple steps:

Take a flexible measuring tape (like a tailor's tape measure).

Place it approximately 2 cm above your eyebrows, passing over your ears.

Measure around the entire circumference of your head, including the back where it is widest.

Note the measurement in centimeters.

Refer to the size chart above to identify your correct size.

A properly fitted helmet should conform to the shape of your head without being too tight or too loose. This ensures optimal protection, a comfortable fit, and pleasant everyday use.

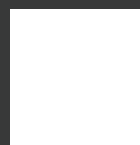

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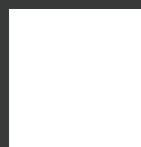


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
